Sunday, July 11, 2021 Summer Sermon Series 2021: "I Have a Question"



What doesn't seem "fair" in life to you? Who does it involve?

Habakkuk, wrestling with God's answer in chapter 1 about using evil forces to bring correction, now moves on to the "fairness" of God's solution. He issues his complaint, then stands and waits (2:1). When I complain to God, how long do I wait to hear his answer? What am I doing while I am waiting?

Read 1:12 again. Habakkuk is trusting in the character and nature of God. How can I better trust in His character when life around me seems unfair?

Read Proverbs 18:10, Psalm 18:1,2. In what ways has God been your strong tower in life?

Reflect on Paul's struggle in in 2 Corinthians 12:7-9. When have I failed to accept God's grace in a struggle I have had and rather chose to rebel and run from God? What will help me to have different response?

Read 2:2. To whom could I speak a word of encouragement from my experience as to God's faithfulness?

The world is not fair; God is always faithful. Remember the difference

Thoughts on God's "fairness"

- 1. I stand in what I know, not what I perceive. Ephesians 6
- 2. I Wait Isaiah 40:31
- 3. I take time to listen- Palm 62:1
- 4. I record and rehearse Deuteronomy 6:4
- 5. I believe God is in control and can handle it better than I can-Colossians 1:17
- 6. I remember- Psalm 103:2

As I think through, pray through this list, which point do I struggle with the most? With whom can I pray to ask God to help me grow in each of these areas of my relationship and understanding with him?
