Ezra 7:1-10

Do you thrive on chaos or order? Why?

Ezra 7 God now uses Ezra in the next chapter of His restart. He uses him to teach and instruct because Israel has forgotten God's teachings. Read Jeremiah 44:23. Which of God's teachings have I ignored or neglected in my life? How has that affected me?

Read Ezra 7:10. Ezra is used because he knows, lives and able to teach. In regards to God's teaching, which of these do I do the best with? Which do I struggle the most?

Read Acts 17:11. God saw the Israelites lack of knowledge as an obstacle to their being rebuilt. Where do I think my knowledge of God's teachings are lacking?

Read and take time to reflect on Matthew 28, "The Great Commission." What is God saying to me about my growth as a disciple, and my discipleship of someone else?

Ezra 1-6 documents the beginning of the return of Israel after the exile. God begins by using Zerubbabel to re-establish worship. Is worship for me a destination in my spiritual life, or transition point?

This week, "What will I do with what I have just heard?" "With whom will I share what I have learned?"
