Nehemiah outlines 7 steps in rebuilding a relationship with God
Step 1 was changing their (Nehemiah 9:1)
What attitude do I need to change?
What choice is God calling me to make?

Step 3 is confession of sin (Nehemiah 9:2)
What sin do I need to confess before God?
Step 4 is a focus on (Nehemiah 9:3)
What truth from scripture do I need to a reminder?
Step 5 isof God (Nehemiah 9:5)
What aspect of God's character, nature can I celebrate today?
Step 6 is remembering God's to me (Nehemiah 9:7)
How has God been faithful to you?
Step 7 is being open and (Nehemiah 9:37)
What need in my life am I keeping from God?
Read Hebrews 4:15,16. How does this verse give me confidence in my relationship with God?
THIS FALL: Am I ready to start over in my relationship with God?
What will I do about my relationship with Him?
