

What do we look for in leaders?
Saul was a king. Read 1 Samuel 10:17-24.
How does this interaction with Saul foreshadow what type of king he might be?
Israel as a nation appointed him king in the face of God's warnings. When have we ignored God's warnings? What happened?
How can I use this account in scripture to change how I view, make requests to God? How can I better discern if my requests are wants or needs?
What steps will I take to foster a deeper relationship with Jesus?
