I will be joining **Eliot Baptist** on a spiritual enrichment trip to **Israel** in **October/November**. I am greatly looking forward to this trip as I have always dreamed of such as opportunity, but never really thought would come to fruition.

January '24 see us joining with 5 college campuses served by MD's **Campus Ambassadors** on mission trip to **San Salvador**, **El Salvador** to work renovating a home into a church building. This may prove to be the largest team we've had the privilege to lead.
