***Hebrews 6:13-22***

Hope is a word we use so often and believe in so little. We think of hope as if the outcome is in question. Biblical hope never questions the outcome because it is grounded in God. It does sometimes question the journey we take to get there.

Take a moment to read *Psalms 42:5*. What is troubling my soul today?

Hebrews is a book that builds a solid case on who Jesus is and what He has done for me. Many are familiar with *Hebrews 11*, “The role call of faith.” But before faith, the author builds a case for hope.

Read *Hebrews 6:1*. What are the basic teachings of the faith you feel you need move past and in what areas do you need to grow?

Read *Hebrews 6:13-14*.
