"Are We There Yet?" John 12:12-19

How do you respond when someone asks you, "Are we there yet?

Palm Sunday, the "Triumphal Entry" signals a turning point in Jesus' ministry. It is the time when Jesus steps out of the shadows, into full public view and acknowledges the acclaims of the crowds- and invokes the anger of the religious leaders

John, in his gospel charts Jesus' journey from the beginning of eternity (read John 1:14), with Palm Sunday, and the events of this week as just one chapter in Jesus' existence. It is a time when the disciples who originally followed Jesus, (John 1:35-39) will be tested to see how far they, and we will follow him.
