Read *Mark 1:14, Colossians 1:13*. What do these verses tell me about my standing in God’s kingdom today?

Read *Matthew 13:40-43, Romans 14:10,11, Revelation 14:10,11*.

Jesus and the NT writers make a point to let us know that when God’s kingdom is revealed there are benefits to me, and consequences for others.

How often do I think of the consequences of the coming kingdom to those around me? How would that change my life if I did?

We can’t talk about being a committed follower of Jesus, member of His kingdom without talking about our responsibility to those around us.
