Another motive of praise to God is his provision for Fundación Emanuel (Emanuel Foundation) – the children at risk ministry in Cochabamba, which has occurred. The vision of the ministry has been to reach out with the Gospel and provide daily educational and nutritional support to more children. Space in the present property that houses the

ministries, and finances, have limited the number of children that can be worked with to about 50 children. It's been the dream to purchase a larger property to reach out to double or triple the number of children. The news – funds have been given and a larger property is now purchased. The new property is in the same neighborhood as the present property, which is an additional cause for praise as the location remains in the area of need.
