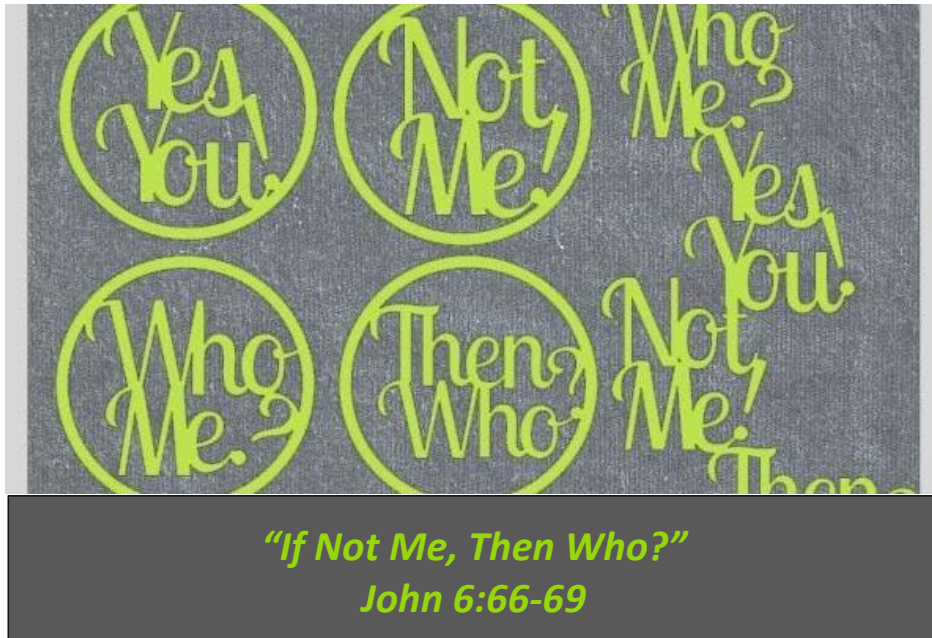


Sunday – October 1, 2023
