Read *Revelation 22:12,13*.

Scripture is clear that one day all will face Jesus as he sits on his throne. Read *2 Corinthians 5:9-10*.

Am I prepared to meet Jesus as King, knowing he will have the final word on my life? What needs to change in my life now to prepare me for that day?
