Our latest Voices Rising newsletter is here! In this issue, we look at the many ways God is working in and through our programs to empower and elevate the dignity of the war-affected young people and their communities.

Did you know that 44 percent of all forcibly displaced people worldwide are in Africa? Among those refugees entering Uganda from neighboring countries are rising numbers of child-headed families. ChildVoice is now providing household wellness support and skills training to fourteen such families, including that of Samuel, a Congolese boy who was just 12 years old when he was left in charge of his siblings and cousin after fleeing violence in his home country.



Meanwhile, in Nigeria students and staff celebrated this past March as our third class of Malkohi students graduated from their programs, marking the largest graduating class yet in our Malkohi location!

Consider the power of soap. It's such a common household item that we barely give it a second thought. But in refugee and IDP contexts, it's a source of empowerment. With international aid shrinking, soap making is becoming an increasingly profitable and vital skill.
